

RECORD & REPORT

When a dairy animal arrives at your farm, it is your responsibility to **record** and **report** the move-in event.

The following is required:

- 15-digit animal ID number on the ear tag;
- Date of arrival / move-in;
- Premises ID (PID) of the arrival and departure points including, but not limited to, the license plate of the transport vehicle.

Also, it is recommended good practice to **record** and **report** any animal **departure** from your farm.

ARRIVES ON FARM

RECORD REPORT

WITHIN 7 DAYS OF ARRIVAL OR BEFORE ANIMAL LEAVES THE FARM, WHICHEVER COMES FIRST.

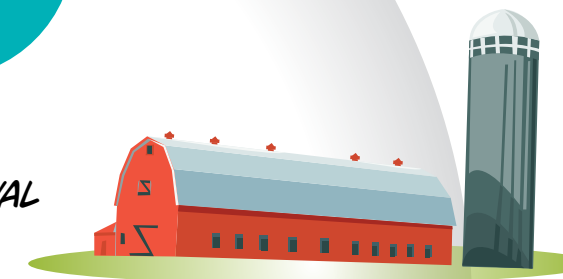

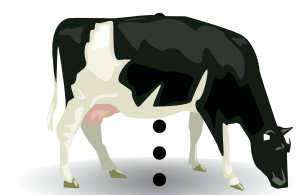
RECORD REPORT

WITHIN 7 DAYS OF DEPARTURE FOR DAIRY FARMERS, OTHERWISE 30 DAYS.



FOR AFFILIATES, DAIRYTRACE PROMOTES THE RECORDING AND REPORTING OF ALL MOVEMENT AS A GOOD PRACTICE.

FOR IMPORTED ANIMALS FROM ANOTHER COUNTRY, YOU WILL NEED THE ADDRESS FROM WHERE THE ANIMAL DEPARTED FROM AND THE VEHICLE/TRAILER LICENSE PLATE NUMBER, AS THEY WILL NOT HAVE A RECOGNIZED PREMISES ID.



BORN ON FARM

RECORD REPORT

WITHIN 7 DAYS OF BIRTH OR BEFORE ANIMAL LEAVES THE FARM, WHICHEVER COMES FIRST.

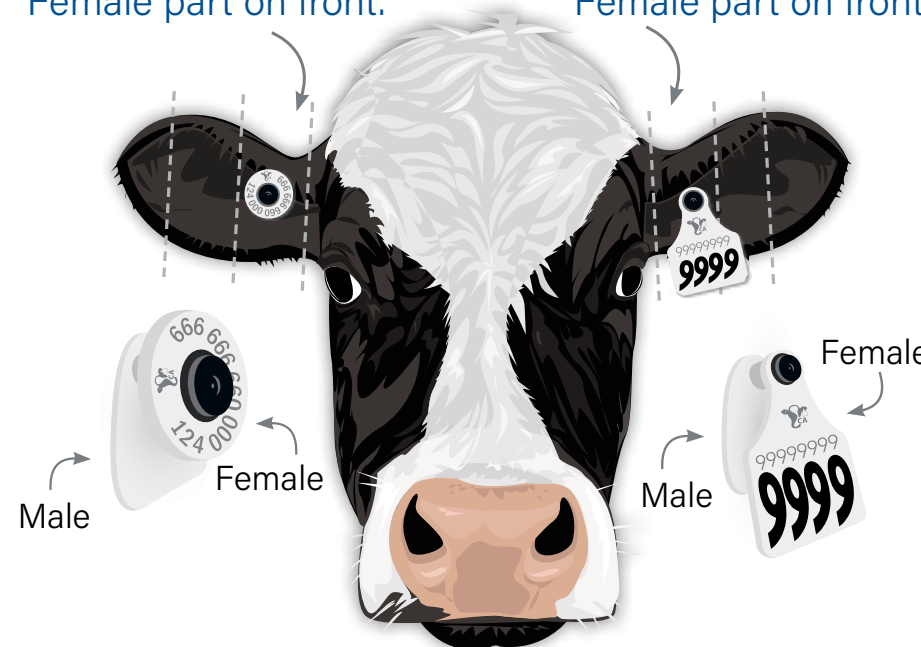
WITHIN 45 DAYS OF BIRTH OR BEFORE ANIMAL LEAVES THE FARM, WHICHEVER COMES FIRST.

TAG WITHIN 7 DAYS OF BIRTH OR BEFORE ANIMAL LEAVES THE FARM, WHICHEVER COMES FIRST.

TAG POSITIONING

RIGHT EAR
Electronic set put on the **first third** of ear with Male part on back, Female part on front.

LEFT EAR
Visual set put on the **first third** of ear with Male part on back, Female part on front.



TAG REPLACEMENT OR LOSS

RECORD REPORT

WITHIN 7 DAYS IF NEW TAG NUMBER IS USED.

IF THE SAME TAG NUMBER CAN IMMEDIATELY BE RE-ORDERED, REPORTING IS REQUIRED ONCE APPLIED.

DEATH

RECORD REPORT

WITHIN 7 DAYS OF DEATH FOR DAIRY FARMERS, OTHERWISE 30 DAYS.

IF ANIMAL IS PICKED UP BY A RENDERER, THE TAGGED CARCASS WILL BE REPORTED AND THE TAG WILL BE RETIRED BY THE TERMINAL SITE.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT YOU ACTIVATE TAGS THE SAME DAY THEY ARE APPLIED.
