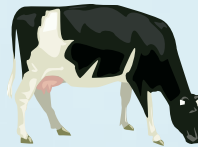
ARE YOU GOING TO A FAIR?

When people and animals from different farms gather in one location to celebrate agriculture through fairs and exhibitions, there is a higher likelihood of infectious diseases spreading.

This is why reporting arrivals to and departures of dairy animals from fairs is so important. A dedicated traceability system like DairyTrace gives us the ability to identify an animal's current location and where it's been, enabling faster response in an emergency.

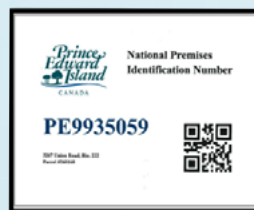
HERE IS A HANDY CHECKLIST OF WHAT YOU NEED TO DO:

- ☐ Report a **Move-out** from the farm even if the animal is only leaving temporarily (highly recommended).
- ☐ Report a **Move-in** when the animal returns home (required under proAction).



WHAT YOU'LL NEED:

- ☐ The **premises identification (PID) of departure** (last stop before arrival).
- ☐ The **PID of the fair location**.
 - Check for the PID on the show registration documents, website or even a sign posted on site. You may also be able to find the PID in the public premises search in the DairyTrace portal.
- ☐ The **license plate number** and province of the transportation truck/trailer
- ☐ **Animal ID#** (15 digits)
